- **Helmets are required for all participants** Clothing: Helmet, neck gator, waterproof pants, jacket, and gloves or mittens Sun screen and lip balm. Don't forget eye protection. Bring sunglasses or goggles; goggles are preferred-weather conditions can change guickly!
- Bring your skis. Wear your boots. Only bring poles to January 6th day if child is pole Equipment: planting consistently.
- Lunch: Lunch is \$12 a day. - Lift Tickets: Season pass – well sealed inside LEFT JACKET POCKET or on a lanyard! Don't forget to bring your pass every Saturday. If you do forget it let your Ski/Snowboard Pro know right away. The Aspen Skiing Company will only issue one replacement ticket per child. per season.

On the Skills Day each child will receive an "under 6" button, please bring to each lesson.

You may not drop off at the loading zone on Boomerang Drive! Parking :

> **1 HOUR FREE PARKING, MUST HAVE THE YELLOW ENCLOSED BIGHORN PASS ON** YOUR WINDSHIELD. This pass will be mailed to you in December. Carpooling is encouraged!

Paid Parking: HOV (four or more people) park for FREE in the main parking structure at the base of Aspen Highlands. Paid parking is enforced from 7:30 am to noon daily. No charge for vehicles arriving after noon, space available. Daily parking fee is \$12 on week days and \$25 on weekends and holidays.
