




## EXPENSES AND REVENUE 2017-2021




TOTAL REVENUE: \$6,399,690

EP: All of it!


### Do you like snowy powder days or sunny blue days?

EP: Snowy Powder Days! | DS: Sunny Days! Well both...


### What do you wish you could tell the world about AVSC?

Hanna Faulhaber, AVSC freestyle athlete, started with AVSC at age three. She made her way through AVSC's Basecamp programs (now ASK) and started on the Freestyle Devo team at 8 years old. Hanna shined at every freestyle discipline from moguls to Big Mountain before deciding to pursue Park and Pipe. She is now a US Ski Team athlete heading to the 2022 Olympics. We sat down with Hanna to get a better understanding of the influence AVSC has had on her career.



## Athlete Spotlight:

**Hanna Faulhaber**

### What are you most looking forward to this season?

HF: I'm looking forward to all of the competitions and training, even though I will be away from home a lot, I love the rush of competing.

### How has your time at AVSC influenced your recent achievements?

HF: My time at AVSC is the reason that I am competing at such a high level. Going through all of the individual programs within AVSC prepared me for everything that I have achieved.

### What do you hope other athletes take away from AVSC programs and watching an athlete like you succeed?

HF: I hope that the younger generation have as much fun as I did going through all of the programs. I hope that I inspire them to follow their dreams.

### What is your proudest moment in your career?

HF: My proudest moment in my career so far was World Championships in Aspen. I didn't expect much out of it at first but kept surprising myself throughout the competition and ended up with 4th. It was also great to compete at home.

### Favorite memory as a young athlete with AVSC?

HF: There have been so many memories throughout AVSC. One that really stands out to me was first 360 into the airbag.

### How do you balance school and your training?

HF: After my freshman year of high school I realized that with my ski schedule I would need to take online classes. For sophomore year I took a few classes in school and a few online. This enabled me to leave school early and go up to the mountain to train. Then because of Covid I took everything online during my junior year. This was mainly because I didn't want to compromise my chances of training and competing. This year I am a senior and nearly done with all the graduation requirements. I am planning to get them done before training and competitions keep me busy.

### What is a day in the life of Hanna Faulhaber?

HF: I am constantly traveling and following the snow, but when I am home, I love free skiing with my friends. Once I'm back home I usually do some school work, cook and eat dinner and either play cards or watch something on TV. A big part of my day is going to bed. A lot of the time if I'm going to try a new trick I visualize it the night before while listening to music.

### Favorite Trick?

HF: My favorite trick to do in the halfpipe is a flair. I love to go upside down and watch the earth spin around me.

### Favorite place to compete?

HF: I have been to so many cool places to compete. A big one for me was being able to compete in World Champs in my hometown, Aspen. However, one of the most beautiful places that I competed in was definitely Leysin, Switzerland.



## Program Spotlight: Summer Mountain Bike Program

We sat down with Meredith Elwell, AVSC's Summer Mountain Bike (SMB) Program Director and one of the many people that made this program successful, to learn about the growth and program offerings.

### **Tell us about the SMB Program.**

It is a recreational program that involves components of terrain-based learning, cross country riding, and even downhill riding. We offer a variety of programs that help fit into different families schedules and interests. The program launched in 2015 to give our athletes and community additional summer programming options.

### **How has the SMB Program evolved over the years?**

Our summer bike programs have taken on many variations over the years. We have worked hard to match the fast-paced growth in the bike world, while listening to what our communities programming needs. We have built great momentum and have extended our network of trust to biking in the summer. We have grown from 50 riders to over 500 riders in this past summer, 2021. This speaks volumes for the interest in biking and our ability to do what we do best – offer top quality programming to youth in our valley!

### **Where do summer bike athletes train?**

Our summer bike programs are based out of Crown Mountain Park in El Jebel, Co. This location gives us a central location for access to the entire valley of trails. We typically start lessons with skills training in Crown Mountain Park, taking advantage of their incredible features for skill building and assessment. Older riders in our Devo program (age 9-13) will explore the trails from Sky Mountain Park to Glenwood Springs. Our up and-coming riders, Pre-Devo (age 7-9) will continue developing skills and exploring fun flow trails.

### **What does the Bike and Build Program entail?**

AVSC's Bike & Build is a one-of-a-kind program that is a mix of riding and bike mechanics through our partnership with Way of Compassion's Bike Project. AVSC works with local resources to seek out 5th – 8th graders that have a passion for biking. This program meets once a week for 4-6 weeks for a full day of fun, starting with a trail ride, followed by an afternoon in the Bike Project's space learning about how a bikes are made and maintained. By the end of the program, the kids will have a hand in building a bike (from scratch!).

## What does the future of the SMB program look like?

I think the foundation of our SMB program is strong. The balance of programming we currently offer is attractive to families and works with their schedules. We have committed and passionate coaches which is the key to making it all work. I see us expanding our enrollment to new athletes in our valley that hopefully translates to their winter participation and vice versa. I believe we will continue to push ourselves based on community needs and helping meet these demands; which could include expanding recreational opportunities, fall biking offerings, a travel opportunity and eventually exposure to competitions.


## How do you address the barrier to entry in Mountain Biking?

AVSC offers program fee scholarships for all of our programs on a need basis. In terms of bike equipment, AVSC has an impressive fleet of bikes that are available to any rider who does not have their own bike at no charge. We also offer transportation for our riders to access trails. Bike & Build is free for all participants. Athletes are referred to the program from local school liaisons, and community leaders.

## What do you want athletes to get out of SMB?

It is important that AVSC can offer our athletes and community ways to stay engaged over the summer months. It reinforces the importance of social engagement with peers, the value of leading a healthy lifestyle through outdoor activities and the opportunity to push athletes out of their comfort zone to achieve a higher level of confidence in a skill or activity.

## Coach Spotlight:

Gill Hearn –Alpine Youth Programs Coordinator

### How long have you been involved in AVSC?

I grew up racing with AVSC. It was a very exciting when I was able to transfer to AVSC from the ski school when I was about 11 years old. I raced with AVSC through a PG year at the club before going to Montana State University. I returned to the Roaring Fork Valley after eight years in Montana to coach for a year, and 10 years later I am still here, loving coaching every day!

### What about coaching for AVSC is rewarding to you?

I love seeing growth, and watching kids find success on and off the slopes whatever their goals may be. It is very rewarding to see the core values of AVSC on display the athlete's athletic endeavors, as well as their lives away from sport. Seeing kids make AVSC a home and community is what first drew me here as an athlete and keeps me coaching here today!

### What is your coaching philosophy?

I feel strong technical foundation for each athlete is the building block to building a ski career and reach the highest level of racing they dream of. Technical growth and change are made outside of courses with quality repetition in free skiing and drills, then applying the skill to different course sets and terrain. A strong team culture is built for each athlete to feel comfortable to push their own limits, and step outside their individual comfort zone.

### Who were some of your role models growing up and their qualities that you looked up to?

I have always looked up to my dad. As a 40-year veteran of the Aspen Mountain Ski Patrol, he showed me that you can find a way to make a career out of doing what you love the most. He instilled in me a love for the mountains and taught me that there is no such thing as a bad day of skiing!

### What is your favorite memory or day of coaching?

Skiing Trainor Ridge on Aspen Mountain with my U16 group and my dad. That area of the mountain has always been his pride and joy. I had coached many of the athletes in that group since they were U10s. That day the kids became the coaches, encouraging each other to push their limits. I will never forget seeing the joy on all of their faces skiing powder as a team.

### If you could give one piece of advice to young AVSC athletes, what would it be?

Follow your heart, dream big and SKI FAST!!
