Because our funds are limited, scholarship assistance will be contingent upon financial need. Please understand that all AVSC participants receive financial aid since program fees do not cover the actual cost of providing these programs, thanks to our generous Donors. Families whose combined adjusted gross income is less than \$175,000 or families experiencing financial hardship are encouraged to apply.

Competitive Team program applicants are eligible for up to 60% of program fees.

## **CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

All participants receiving a scholarship must meet the following conditions. Failure to meet these requirements will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship award.

- The recipient must abide by the AVSC Code of Conduct and be a resident of the Roaring Fork Valley or Western Garfield County.
- All recipients will be required to write a letter of thanks on behalf of AVSC (post-season, details to follow).
- A copy of the letter of thanks must be sent to AVSC to be eligible for the scholarship in the following season.
- All past balances must be paid in full.
