


WHERE DO AVSC PARTICIPANTS LIVE?


Scholarship Increase 2016-2020:




AVSC FINANCIAL SNAPSHOT




2020 Revenue and Expense Detail

A DECADE OF AUDI AJAX CUP

On December 30th, 2019, we celebrated our 10th annual Audi Ajax Cup, where we raised \$900,000 for local youth to participate in winter sports! Sixteen Audi Ajax Cup race teams were each paired with a professional skier, including legendary American Downhiller Daron Rahlves, AVSC (and US Ski Team) Alumni Katie Ryan and Jake Zamansky, and pros from the Canadian, Swedish, and US National Teams.

The Ajax Cup was decided in the final race between team Alpine Bank and team 'West End Hillbillies.' Alex Ferreira (AVSC Alumnus, two-time XGames Champion, and Olympic Silver Medalist) bested US Ski Team Alumnus Nolan Kasper in an extremely close race to take the win for the West End Hillbillies, led by team captains Adam Lewis and Jimmie Johnson (seven-time NASCAR champion).

After the excitement on the hill, partygoers convened downtown for dancing, a live auction, and the presentation of the Gorsuch Cup with one-of-a-kind sterling silver and gold belt buckles, donated by Gorsuch, given to the winning team.

PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: BILL KOCH YOUTH SKI LEAGUE IN CARBONDALE

A Valley-Wide Entry Point to a Lifelong Love of Skiing

We sat down with August Teague, AVSC's Nordic Program Director, to learn more about AVSC's Bill Koch Youth Ski League at Spring Gulch.

What is the Bill Koch Youth Ski League (BKL)?

August: BKL is a recreational learn-to-cross-country-ski program for athletes in kindergarten through fourth grade. AVSC first hosted the program in Aspen and then built upon existing programs down valley just over five years ago.

How has the BKL program evolved in the past five years?

A: We have worked on the accessibility of our programs, working with community leaders in Carbondale – school counselors, Valley Settlement, etc. – to identify underrepresented youth who would benefit from and enjoy cross-country skiing. We learned that there were a few common barriers to participation: cost of program and equipment, transportation to and from training, and providing the kids with the fuel (snacks!) to participate. We worked to overcome those barriers and started by inviting 20 kids to ski with us, free of charge, in 2017. That number has doubled in three years. Our original goal was to provide full scholarships to 50 kids in five years; we are on track to hit that target.

How did you overcome those barriers - cost, transportation, and... snacks?

A: We were able to provide equipment and robust program scholarships thanks to the incredible generosity of AVSC donors and grants. We partner with Roaring Fork School District (just like we do for the ASK program!) to drive athletes from school to Spring Gulch and back. And lastly, we partner with local restaurants on the all-important snacks! It's a signature of Bill Koch to end each day with hot cocoa as well.





What does a day in the life of a BKL athlete look like for an athlete that's receiving this level of support?

A: Athletes hop on the bus and head to Spring Gulch. They play a warm-up game and then break up into age/ability groups to ski. They'll wrap up with another game, enjoy some hot cocoa, and ride the bus back to meet their families. Every day is a little different– there are more jumps built than you'd imagine for a cross-country venue!

What do you hope athletes take away from their time in the BKL program?

A: I hope the program is a healthy and supportive way to learn about life: taking risks, setting goals, failing and succeeding, being a good teammate. Athletics are an amazing tool to cross cultural barriers; I hope kids make friends and the program is a conduit to unify our community. Competition is incredibly important, too. I want kids to build confidence, but I also want to give them an avenue to develop the skills and knowledge to compete with the best.

What's your favorite memory from the Bill Koch Youth Ski League thus far?

A: Some of our athletes moved to Carbondale from warmer climates and have never seen snow before, much less skied on it! To see them cruising around on skis just a few weeks after joining the program is awesome.

Sounds awesome. Can we come check it out?

A: Anyone can come ski at Spring Gulch – it is free thanks to the Mount Sopris Nordic Council! It is Simi Hamilton's (US Ski Team member and AVSC Alum) favorite place to ski, and let's just say he's traveled around the globe for skiing. Its trails provide a totally unobstructed form of nature – no highways, no lifts, no machines in sight – and it comes complete with incredible Mount Sopris views.

Aspen Supports Kids Parent & Bus Driver

Why do you volunteer your time for Aspen **Support Kids?**

Ricardo: I consider it my moral obligation, and I hope that this small contribution of mine can help AVSC continue to provide the possibility to many children to ski. Skiing is an expensive sport even for the ones living in this beautiful playground. There are some families struggling with bills and if it weren't for this particular program it wouldn't be possible for our children to enjoy skiing. Another privilege that the program gives me is the possibility of being a school bus driver.

What do you think makes Aspen Supports Kids unique?

R: It is not limited only to children spending the day skiing in the mountains. What the program offers is a whole process from the day of enrollment, with the help of scholarships and obtaining the necessary equipment to be able to ski. And during a normal day of skiing, knowing and seeing that there is a whole team of volunteers coordinated in favor of our children having a pleasant day is what gives me as a parent the confidence to send my children to participate.

What have your kids gotten out of participating in AVSC?

R: Alexa and Richie are gaining confidence in themselves. They also gain the opportunity to practice a sport that I never could.

Sam Coffey was an accomplished and enthusiastic Aspen Valley Ski & Snowboard Club ski racer. Growing up, he'd occasionally skip school and training, following the five inch rule to ski on powder days with his friends until the last chair. He went on to win Junior Nationals and eventually excel at the University of New Hampshire where he was a two-time All American in NCAA competition. Upon retiring from ski racing, Sam found his true passion in mountaineering and big line skiing in the Elk range as well as Chamonix and the world over. Sam treasured Aspen and loved to ski, especially with his friends, 'The Freaks'!

The Samuel Ryan Coffey Memorial Fund was created to honor Sam's memory and help FIS-level Alpine athletes seeking summer training opportunities. Athletes must demonstrate AVSC's core values of commitment, teamwork, and integrity as well as embody Sam's passion for skiing and the Aspen community.

SKIING & SNOWBOARDING at Buttermilk Glacier, Copper Mountain, CO, and Mt. Hood, OR


MOUNTAIN BIKING at Snowmass Bike Park, Crown Mountain Park, and Prince Creek


